



Virginia Teen Statistics for 2020

Motor Vehicle Crashes, Injuries, and Fatalities in Virginia Involving Teens Aged 15- 20

All Teens (drivers, passengers, pedestrians, bicyclists, etc.):

- ▶ 64 teens killed
- ▶ 6,288 teens injured
- ▶ 798 teens seriously injured
- ▶ 34 (63%) of the teens killed were unrestrained

Crashes Involving Teen Drivers:

- ▶ 19,257 crashes involving a teen driver
- ▶ 86 fatal crashes involving a teen driver
- ▶ 37 Teen Drivers Killed in Crashes
- ▶ 4,394 Teen Drivers Injured in Crashes
- ▶ 491 Teen Drivers Seriously Injured in Crashes
- ▶ 19 (56%) of the Teen Drivers Killed were Unrestrained

Top Causative Factors in Fatal Crashes involving a teen driver:

(Number of Male drivers vs. Number of Female drivers)

54 (63%) of the fatal crashes involved **SPEED**

- Males: 44
- Females: 10

31 (36%) of the fatal crashes were caused by **RUN-OFF-THE-ROAD**

- Males: 23
- Females: 8

19 (22%) of the fatal crashes were **ALCOHOL-RELATED**

- Males: 16
- Females: 3

10 (12%) of the fatal crashes were caused by **INATTENTION/DISTRACTIONS**

- Males: 9
- Females: 1
