The price for the Retreat is only \$15 per person. The deadline to register is June 21, but register early to reserve your spot for the B.R.A.K.E.S. Defensive Driving experience as space is limited to the first 60 students with a learner's or driver's license who register to participate (see retreat registration form and the YOVASO website at yovaso.org/summer-retreat/ for more details on the B.R.A.K.E.S. program).

The B.R.A.K.E.S. program will require ALL Retreat attendees and staff to travel off campus to a location large enough to hold such a driving event. Students who are not driving or riding with B.R.A.K.E.S. will also travel off campus to participate in the YOVASO Distracted Driving Simulator and other driving type rotations. This session will be at the Manheim in Harrisonburg at 3560 Early Road, Harrisonburg, VA 22801, approximately 5 miles from the JMU campus. YOVASO will be using JMU transportation to charter a bus to take the students back forth from campus to the location. This off-campus activity will be on Friday, July 12, with the bus departing at 7:30 a.m. and returning to campus at 12:30 pm.

*Note: The Retreat will involve participants being outside for several hours each day, sit/stand/pay attention for 1-2 hours, walk/run for short distances, and be engaging with a diverse group of students.
